惜食堂 – 惜食全方位食物回收及永續餸愛教育推廣計劃 Food Angel - We Link We Share Programme



惜食堂致力減少食物浪費,於領展鮮活街市及商場回收可食用的剩食,並把其製作成 營養飯餐及食物包,免費派發予長者、低收入家庭及有需要人士。全年目標回收逾 375噸食物,惠及超過130萬人次。計劃除了提供食物援助,亦結合青年教育元素,培 訓大學生成為教育大使,走入校園及社區推廣惜食文化,促進共融及可持續社區。


Food Angel is committed to reducing food waste by collecting edible surplus food from Link's fresh markets and shopping centres, turning it into nutritious meals and food packs for the elderly, low-income families, and those in need. This year, the goal is to recycle over 375 tonnes of food and benefit more than 1.3 million people. In addition to food assistance, the project incorporates youth education by training university students as ambassadors to promote food-wise culture in schools and communities, fostering an inclusive and sustainable society.

After years of effort, the Environmental Association has built ten butterfly gardens at Link's shopping centres, creating an ecological network to boost biodiversity. The project leverages gardens as a platform for community sustainability, with trained volunteers leading workshops and eco-tours to promote conservation. Volunteers will also join exchange activities in Chinese Mainland to learn garden design and management, applying knowledge to support future development of local butterfly gardens.

「聲連銀齡,手牽共融」長者聽力健康計劃



Listen & Connect: Hearing Health Programme for Elderly

在長者健康議題上,聽力健康常被忽視。計劃聯同醫療專業人員與長者服務機構走進社區,提供聽力篩查、輔導、手語學習及講座,協助長者及早識別聽力退化,提升溝通能力,並培訓退休人士成為「銀齡聽力健康大使」,協助提供篩查及輔導服務,助 長者突破溝通障礙,重拾自信。

Hearing health is often overlooked in elderly care. This project partners with healthcare professionals and elderly organisations to provide screenings, counselling, sign language workshops, and talks, helping seniors recognise hearing loss early and communicate better. Retired seniors are trained as "Silver-Age Hearing Health Ambassadors" to support screenings and counselling, enabling seniors to overcome communication barriers and regain confidence.



Arts' Options



「長・智・戲」金齡多元藝術扎根計劃 Deep-rooted Multi Performing Arts Programme for Golden Agers

計劃以表演藝術突破傳統長者社會服務框架,發掘長者的戲劇潛能,提升他們 的自我價值及身心健康,讓他們在無給上大放異彩。多年來,計劃已培育多位金齡藝術人才,來年將推出深造進修課程提升學員的戲劇技巧,並安排長者落區實習帶領戲劇工作坊。計劃亦舉辦社區巡演及第二屆「香港金齡藝術節」, 促進跨代及跨界交流,深化金齡藝術在社區的影響力。

The project leverages performing arts to break traditional elderly service models, unlocking seniors' drama potential to enhance self-worth and well-being, enabling them to shine on stage. Over the years, it has nurtured many senior artists. Looking forward, the project will continue offering advanced courses to enhance participants' drama skills and arrange community internships where seniors lead drama workshops. It will also feature community performance tours and the second Hong Kong Creative Ageing Arts Festival to foster intergenerational and cross-sector exchange, deepening the impact of creative ageing in the community.

我與堅韌同行



Empower ME: Journey to Resilience WW

香港非華裔青年常面對歧視、身分認同和家庭衝突等挑戰,引致自尊心低落和心理 健康問題。計劃透過創意工作坊、一對一的人生教練輔導和社區探索,幫助南亞裔 青年建立自信、韌性和歸屬感。參與者將透過藝術和短片製作表達自我,思考未來 方向,並透過展覽分享故事,讓社區了解他們更多。計劃亦將邀請青年的家人參 與,促進家庭溝通。透過整全的介入方式,讓非華裔青年被看見、被聆聽,促進社 會擁抱多元文化。

Non-Chinese youths in Hong Kong often face issues such as discrimination, identity struggles, and family conflict, leading to low selfesteem and mental health challenges. The project supports South Asian youths in building confidence, resilience, and a sense of belonging through a journey of creative workshops, one-on-one life coaching, and community exploration. Participants will express themselves through art and video, while envisioning their future paths. Their stories will be shared with the public via exhibitions to foster greater understanding. The project also engages their families to facilitate communication. Through this holistic approach, the project aims to help non-Chinese youths feel seen and heard, inspiring the community to embrace diversity.

「山x海x城」戶外運動旅程2.0 Sports LinkVenture 2.0

「山x海x城」計劃為基層青少年提供多元化的運動體驗,包括為初學者及進階參 加者度身設計水上、城市及山野運動課程,鼓勵學生走出舒適圈,建立自信、團隊 合作及情緒管理能力。參加者所累積的運動時數將轉化為環保運動用品包,送給基 層兒童,既问饋社會,亦推廣可持續生活理念。此外,計劃增設於不同地區舉辦小 型運動聚會,由專業教練及受訓的青少年帶領公眾參與,促進社區健康與連結。

This year's project continues to provide diverse sports experiences for underprivileged youths. Through tailored beginner-friendly and intermediate courses in water, urban, and mountain sports, students are encouraged to step out of their comfort zones while developing confidence, teamwork, and emotional resilience. The hours of sport activities they accumulate will be converted into eco-friendly sports packs for underprivileged children, promoting a spirit of giving back to the society and sustainable living. In addition, the project will host small-scale sports gatherings across districts, led by professional coaches and trained youths to foster community health and connection.

Link and Explore – Community and Career Exploration 2.0 👑 😈

計劃透過遊戲化學習及學生互助的模式,幫助基層中學生探索職涯方向並與社 區建立連結。今年計劃將擴展至更多地區參與,促進跨校及跨界合作,提升學生與良師香港的歷屆項目老師、企業夥伴及社區組織的連繫。來自不同地區的中學生將與大學生及年輕教師配對,透過實地考察、訪談及社區研究,為朋輩設計行別生務及參與體驗式學習活動,從而深入了解社區議題,擴闊職涯視 野,掌握規劃未來的關鍵技能

The project empowers underprivileged secondary school students to explore career pathways and community connections through gamified learning and a student-for-student approach. This year, it will expand its reach and deepen cross-school and cross-sector collaboration, connecting students with Teach For Hong Kong's alumni, corporate partners, and community organisations. Students from various districts will be paired with university mentors and young teachers to learn through site visits, interviews and community research, then design interactive quests and experiential learning campaigns for their peers to deepen understanding of community issues, broaden career exposure, and develop the essential skills to shape their futures.

Connecting People and Nature to **Enhance Community Well-being**

自2020年起,我們資助環保協進會的「連繫自然」計劃,透過在領展商場戶外空間建立蝴蝶園,孕育以商場為本 的蝴蝶棲息地,長遠形成生態熱點。計劃善用領展的物業網絡作為平台推廣生態保育,並招募當區居民、社福機 構以至學校參與建設蝴蝶園,推動社區可持續發展。

Since 2020, we have been sponsoring Environmental Association's Nature LINK project. Through establishing butterfly gardens in the vicinity of Link's shopping centres, the gardens serve as an ecological stepping stone on butterfly conservation, and ecological hotspots in the long run. The project leverages Link's property network as a platform to promote ecological conservation, while engaging residents, social welfare organisations, and schools in building the gardens, fostering sustainable community development.

We have proudly supported Arts' Options since 2019, helping to uncover the dramatic potential and creativity of seniors. Through professional training and community performances, participants have not only honed their theatrical skills but also inspired others by achieving their dreams later in life. The meaningful project has flourished, nurturing a group of seasoned stage actors and leading to the founding of Hong Kong's first senior professional theatre group.

領展大學生獎學金是我們支持青少年發展的旗艦計劃, 透過向家庭三代中的首代大學生提供獎學金,減輕他們 接受大學教育時的經濟負擔,鼓勵青年向上流動。

Link University Scholarship is our flagship youth empowerment programme to support talent development for the future. Through providing scholarships to students who are the first in three generations of their families to attend universities, we hope to help them reduce the economic burden of education and also to promote upward mobility.

領展中學生獎學金

Link Secondary Student Scholarship

領展中學生獎學金旨在表揚中學生在學業上的卓越表現及對學校與社區的積極貢獻。 該獎學金於2025年首度推出,以紀念領展房託上市二十周年和加強我們對青年培育的 承諾。得獎學生均從學業成就、社區參與、義工經驗及面試表現作出甄選,同時參與 培訓工作坊,提升溝通及表達能力,以及加深對社區的認識。

Link Secondary Student Scholarship recognises secondary students for their academic excellence and meaningful contributions to their schools and communities. Launched in 2025 to commemorate the 20th anniversary of Link REIT, the scholarship reinforces our commitment to youth empowerment. Awardees are selected based on their academic achievements, community engagement, volunteer experiences, and interview performance. In addition to receiving the scholarship, students participate in enrichment workshops to strengthen their communication and presentation skills, and deepen their understanding of community issues.









連繫社區 Community Engagement

領展除了提供資金讓社福機構開展慈善項目外,亦善用社區網絡及企業資源以連繫社區,共創價值,實踐領展連繫好生活的理念。 In addition to funding charities and their projects, Link leverages its extensive network in the local communities and collaborates with other stakeholders to create value and link people to a brighter future.

地區支援 Community Support

領展與地區持份者包括社區領袖及公共屋邨的居民團體等密切合作,協力在區內建立網絡,關顧有需要人士,為他們舉辦活動及提供日用包。

Link collaborates with local stakeholders, such as community leaders and resident groups in public housing estates, to build local network and identify people in needs, providing them with recreational activities and grocery packs.

■ 共融社區 Inclusive Community

現時領展在香港的全部物業均已配備基本無障礙通道設施。我們亦是香港首個提供場地作導盲犬培訓用途的商場網絡,致力建立共融社區。

All of Link's Hong Kong properties have now been fitted with basic Barrier-free Access, or BFA facilities. We are also the first in Hong Kong to open its properties for guide dog puppies training, as we aim to promote an inclusive community.

領展義工 Link Volunteers

領展與不同社福機構及持份者合作,鼓勵員工帶同其家人及朋友一起參與義工服務;透過籌款活動、派發節日禮品、為有需要的長者或家庭編織披肩等各類義工活動傳遞關愛訊息,為社區帶來正面的影響。去年領展員工的義工服務達到593人次,時數達2,660小時。

In partnership with charitable organisations and other stakeholders, Link encourages employees, along with their friends and families, to participate in various community services, such as fundraising events, distributing festive goodies, and knitting capelets for elders or families in need, to spread their positivity to the community. A staff count of 593 volunteered a total of 2,660 hours for volunteer services.
