


To be eligible for Link University Scholarship, applicants must show that they are the first-generation university students. Students who apply for the year 2-4 university scholarships[^] can declare their status at Home Affairs Department by following a quick, simple, and free process :

Bring your **identity card** and the **declaration template***

2



Visit one of the enquiry centres in person during the **designated timeslot**^{#**} to make the declaration

Read out the declaration in front of the Commissioner for Oaths

** Students should arrive 15 minutes before the designated time slot for preparatory work (e.g. completion of the form and stamping of the relevant documents).
