Speedy Gonzalez	Each owner puts on a mask and waits at the finishing line. Dog contestants must overcome a series of obstacles and temptations to reach their owner as quickly as possible.
Doggie Styling Competition	The judges will select the best-dressed canine and owner based on looks that best represent their personalities. Winners will be announced on site.

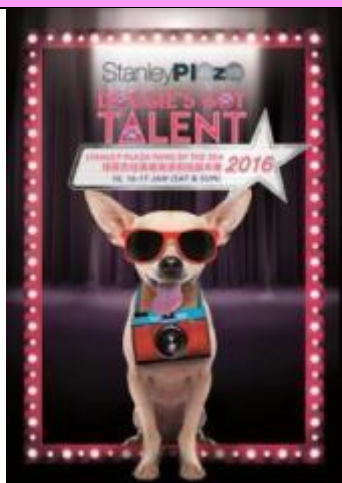
1. Be Artistic @ Doggie Carnival
